DRAMATHERAPY SOUTHWEST WEBSITE



The DSW website enables members to keep in touch with each other and events in the region. It provides news-pages, discussion forums, a resource library, a picture gallery, a 'find a dramatherapist' facility and more.

When you join DSW you pay a one-off joining / website fee of just £10.00 which allows you access to the members area.

For a further one-off fee of £20.00 you can create a web-page within the existing DSW/DTSW website. You are then able to create your own profile enabling you to advertise yourself and your dramatherapy services. You may upload your own biog, pictures, personal details and a portfolio of your work, articles and writings, video clips, blogs, news etc.

Members may advertise their events on the website and some members report obtaining work as a result of displaying their web pages.

## WHAT IS DRAMATHERAPY SOUTHWEST ?

Dramatherapy Southwest is a Regional Professional Association affiliated to the British Association of Dramatherapists, (BADth)

Our aims are to:

- Promote communication between dramatherapists in the region
- Promote Dramatherapy as a therapeutic approach
- Provide a support for practice
- To support continuing professional development (CPD) in line with the Health and Care Professions Council's (HCPC) requirements
- Provide a forum for exchange of ideas and information
- Promote peer group learning
- Provide information about work opportunities

## WHAT DOES DRAMATHERAPY SOUTHWEST PROVIDE FOR MEMBERS?

Throughout the year we organise a series of events and workshops for members:

We start in January with our AGM, usually accompanied by a free workshop, where we discuss our plans for the year ahead.

Thereafter, we offer events during the year which can include conferences and good quality workshops at affordable prices.

Non-members can often attend DSW events, but members are usually charged a significantly lower rate or get to attend/participate for free.

There are also

- Peer group sharing of expertise
- Discussion and CPD forums
- Occasional social events and informal gatherings

All members are encouraged to actively participate in running events and workshops for DSW.

The Dramatherapy South West Committee is elected yearly and meets regularly to organise the programme for the year.

## HOW IS DRAMATHERAPY SOUTHWEST ORGANISED?

The job of the committee is to discern the needs of and act for its members. Committee meetings are open to all members.

Communication between members takes place via:

- emails, workshops, conferences and other meetings
- Newsletters and bulletins which contains information about workshops, arts and social events and provides a forum for discussion between members. Members are often able to advertise their events for free in the newsletters, bulletins and on the website
